- PORTUGAL -

MATERIALS:

- 2.5 mm crochet needle.
- 100% cotton thread (I used Rosários - Lisbon and Matty Yarns), in the colours: red, black, and white.
- Tapestry needle.
- Scissors.
- Filling.
- Turn counter.
- Key chain.

• ABBREVIATIONS:

- **MR** = Magic Ring
- **Ch** = Chain
- **Sc** = Single Crochet
- **Hdc** = Half double Crochet
- **Inc** = Increase
- **Dec** = Decrease

ARMS 2X:

- Black thread -

Rnd 1: 5 sc in MR (5)

Rnd 2: 5 inc (10)

Rnd 3-4: 10 sc (10)

- Red line -

Rnd 5-7: 10 sc (10)

Rnd 8: 1 dec, 3 sc, 1 dec, 3 sc. (8)

- Fasten off and hide the thread inside the arms. Stuff the hand part and leave the rest of the arm unstuffed.

LEGS 2X:

- Black thread -

Rnd 1: 6 sc in MR (6)

Rnd 2: 6 inc (12)

Rnd 3: 12 sc BLO

- Red line -

Rnd 4: 12 sc (12)

- Tie off the first leg and hide the thread inside. On the second leg, do not tie off the thread, go to the body.



BODY (CONTINUATION OF THE 2ND LEG):

- Joins the two legs -

Rnd 5: 24 sc (12 sc on each leg)

Rnd 6: (3 sc, 1 inc) x 6 (30)

Rnd 7-8: 30 sc (30)

- Black thread-

Rnd 9: 30 sc (30)

- Red line -

Rnd 10: 30 sc (30)

Rnd 11: (7 sc, 1 dec) x 1, (14 sc, 1 dec) x 1, 5 sc (28)

Rnd 12: (6 sc, 1 dec) x 1, (13 sc, 1 dec) x 1, 5 sc (26)

Rnd 13: (6 sc, 1 dec) x 1, (12 sc, 1 dec) x1, 4 sc (24)

Rnd 14: (6 sc, 1 dec) x 1, (11 sc, 1 dec) x 1, 3 sc (22)

Rnd 15: (6 sc, 1 dec) x 1, (10 sc, 1 dec) x1, 2 sc (20)

- Start filling your legs -

Rnd 16: 20 sc (5 sc, 4 sc holding 1st arm, 7 sc, 4 sc holding 2nd arm)



HEAD (CONTINUATION OF THE BODY):

- Black thread -

Rnd 17: (4 sc, 1 inc) x 6 (24)

Rnd 18: (3 sc, 1 inc) x 6 (30)

Rnd 19: 2 sc, 1 inc, (4 sc, 1 inc) x 5, 2 sc (36)

Rnd 20: (5 sc, 1 inc) x 6 (42)

Rnd 21-28: 42 sc (42) – 8 rounds

Rnd 29: (5 sc, 1 dec) x 6 (36)

Rnd 30: 36 sc (36)

Rnd 31: 2 sc, 1 dec, (4 sc, 1 dec) x 5, 2 sc (30)

Rnd 32: (3 sc, 1 dec) x 6 (24)

Rnd 33: 1 sc, 1 dec, (2 sc, 1 dec) x 5, 1 sc (18)

- Start stuffing the doll -

Rnd 34: (1 sc, 1 dec) x 6 (12)

Rnd 35: 6 dec (6)

- Finish and close the hole -



HOODIE:

- Red line -

Rnd 1: 6 hdc in MR (6)

Rnd 2: 6 hdc inc (12)

Rnd 3: (1 hdc, 1 inc) x 6 (18)

Rnd 4: 1 hdc, 1 inc, (2 hdc, 1 inc) x 5, 1 hdc (24)

Rnd 5: (3 hdc, 1 inc) x 6 (30)

Rnd 6: 2 hdc, 1 inc, (4 hdc, 1 inc) x 5, 2 hdc (36)

Rnd 7: (5 hdc, 1 inc) x 6 (42)

Rnd 8-9: 42 hdc (42) – 2 rounds

- Don't work the stitch where the marker is, chain 1, turn the work.



HOODIE (CONTINUATION):

Rnd 10: 41 sc, ch 1, turn

Rnd 11: (1 dec, 37 sc, 1 dec), ch 1, turn (39)

Rnd 12: (1 dec, 35 sc, 1 dec), ch 1, turn (37)

Rnd 13: 2 dec, 29 sc, 2 dec), ch 1, turn (33)

Rnd 14-15: 33 sc (33) – 2 rounds

Rnd 16: continue with the “v” part with 6 sc, on the 1st side, 1 sc in the middle, 6 sc on the 2nd side. (13)

- Fasten off and leave thread to sew the hoodie to the doll -



ASSEMBLING:

- Place the hoodie centered and sew by picking up the neck of the doll with the loop from inside the hoodie. Sew only through the last 13 sc we made in round 16.
- Sew two stripes with black thread on the front of the doll. Fasten off.
- Sew the desired geometric shape onto the face of the doll with white thread. Fasten off.
- You can also make some sl st in the belt area.
